### Measures for Prevention and Control of the COVID-19

Teams are required to obtain negative results of Covid testing before leaving for Japan. Also further Covid testing may be arranged by OC during the stay in Japan. The details are announced in Medical Guideline which will be published after confirmation from government authorities of Japan.

The event documents for Medical Guidelines, Instructions for Health Monitoring and all updates will be strictly respected. The delegations are not permitted to leave the competition venue and dedicated hotel, except for official transportation between the two locations.

The participants are responsible for insurance costs of equipment and persons. The OC declines all liabilities for all kinds of damage and injuries/sickness during teams' stay.
