COVID

COVID-19 Rules for the 2022 World Rowing U19 & U23 Championships:

- a. FFP2 masks must be worn in closed spaces (indoors) and are recommended for outside spaces. FFP2 Masks are obligatory on public transport.
- b. There is no requirement for a submission of a PCR or antigen test result for teams to access the event.
- c. There is no requirement for providing a vaccination certificate to participate in the event.

Note: If needed, 8+ will be allowed to use the outside loop for training purposes. The OC will provide marshal and rescue boats as indicated in the traffic rules for training. Please note that the outside loop will NOT be allowed for any boats other than the 8+.

Only athletes, staff a and team accredited to WRU19U23CH are allow to enter the Venue.


During the Accreditation you will receive a colored garbage bags, Yellow – for plastic and Red – for undifferentiated.


All you need, is just follow the signs on the territory of the Venue to throw the colored garbage bags and the paper in the appropriate containers.

Important note:


We kindly ask the Team Managers to explain to their Athletes DO NOT THROW water bottles in the lake. The bottles could be emptied and must be kept in the boat.



TEAM FACILITIES AND SERVICES

CONTROL COMMISSION The Control Commission is located between the incoming and outgoing pontoons. The Control Commission will be in operation during all times the course is officially open.

ATHLETES REGISTRATION Upon arrival, team managers are requested to check their crew entries at the Accreditation Centre.

CREW CHANGES Crew changes & withdrawals before the Draw must be done by completing the Crew Change Form (available at the Accreditation Centre) and submitting them to the World Rowing representative in the Accreditation Centre before the Draw (*by 12:00). Crew Changes after the Draw should be submitted at the World Rowing office at the Venue. For medical substitutions and withdrawals please call the WR Doctor first and inform of your intention before submitting a crew change form. Team Managers must confirm their crews.

CREW PHOTOS Team managers will be notified of the athletes that have not yet had their photographs taken for the World Rowing athlete database. These athletes should report to the Accreditation Centre and have their photographs taken.

BOW NUMBERS Bow numbers will be distributed to crews on the outgoing pontoon and will be collected again at the incoming pontoon.

GPS DEVICES All boats must be fitted with a 'base plate' to hold the GPS timing devices. These plates will be fixed to the boats by a team of OC volunteers and by Swiss Timing technicians from 22-25 July in the boat weighing area. Please ensure that they are in place before the first day of racing.

ADVERTISING Please check the WORLD ROWING Rules of Racing and

related Bye-Laws to ensure that your racing uniforms and boats comply with the advertising rules.

BOAT WEIGHING Boat weighing will take place in the Boat Storage area - see the map of the Venue; Test scales will be available from Friday 22 July and will be open at all times that the Venue is open, except during racing.

ATHLETE WEIGHING Athlete weighing will be located in the Athletes Area near the ERG tent - see the map of the Venue; Test scales will be available from Friday 22 July and will be open during opening hours of the Venue.

BOAT STORAGE The boat racks are situated in the Boathouse Area - see the map of the Venue. The Organising Committee will assign boat racks for all boats. Please respect the rack allocation. Teams are responsible to make sure that their boats are always tied to the racks and are in no-risk of being damaged due to adverse weather conditions.

SERVICE PROVIDERS AND BOAT REPAIR Boat builders are located in the Boat Park - see the map of the Venue.

LAUNCH PONTOONS There are two outgoing pontoons and two incoming pontoons located in front of the Boat Storage Area.

BOAT WASHING The location of the race course is a protected environment and teams are required to wash all their boats before going on the water. Facilities will be provided for washing boats on arrival at the Venue including biodegradable detergents.

No chemical detergents or other sources of environmental pollutants should be used during boat washing. The boat washing area will be close to the Boat Storage Area.

TEAM FACILITIES AND SERVICES

TEAM TENTS An area is available for Team Tents - see the Venue layout for the location. Every team receive an adequate space for their tent. For the electricity connection please ask at the Information Centre.

ERGOMETERS Ergometers for training, warming up and cooling down are provided in the Athletes Area - see the map of the Venue.

CHANGING ROOMS/SANITARY FACILITIES Permanent changing rooms and sanitary facilities are located in the Athletes Area, inside the Lido – see the map of the Venue.

BAG STORAGE There will be a secure area situated near Information Centre at the entrance for athlete's bag storage. The bag drop-off will be open during the official opening times of the course.

VIEWING FOR ATHLETES Athletes can view the races from the Spectators standing area or from the Grandstands if seats are available from Monday 25th to Thursday 28th.

TRANSPORT OFFICE

PARKING ARRANGEMENTS

Boat trailers

There will be a designated area for the boat trailers parking behind the Boat Park – see the map of the Venue.

The teams must unload their boats on the trailer parking and carry their boats to the boat racks, follow the signs and directions to access the boat from the parking through the dedicated entrance. It is possible to access the boat park starting from Friday 22nd July at 09:00 and with the same opening hours as the Venue.
