

## 18<sup>th</sup> edition of the Challenge d'Aviron de Mer Prince Albert II December, 2 & 3 2023



The Challenge d'Aviron de Mer Prince Albert II is proud to announce its 18<sup>th</sup> edition.

Organised by the Société Nautique de Monaco, it will be held on December 2 and 3 2023. The competition format is based on the "new codes" introduced in 2021, with some new developments this year. Here are the highlights:

- → Participation limited to 22 teams, representing the top level of coastal and flat-water rowing. Teams may be made up of rowers from the same club or country, or a mixture of clubs or countries.
- → Each team must be made up of 5 people: two women and two men and one coxswain.
- → The rowers will compete in the following categories: Coastal Women's Solo, Coastal Men's Solo, Coastal Mixed Double and Coastal Coxed Mixed Quadruple scull on the first day of racing.
- → On the second day, competitors will compete in sprint races (500m) in Coastal Mixed Quadruple scull, in a knockout duel in world's famous Hercules Harbor.
- → Depending on their ranking at the end of each course, the teams will earn points which will be accumulated over the competition to reveal, after the last race, the final ranking and the winner of the prestigious Challenge Prince Albert II.

## Renewal of the Prize Money

At the end of the final ranking,  $\in 10,000$  in prize money will be shared between the 4 best teams. The best team will pocket  $\in 4,000$ , the second-placed team  $\in 3,000$ , the third-placed team  $\in 2,000$  and the fourth-placed team  $\in 1,000$ .
