Coastal Rowing

Framed against iconic coastal & city views,

and European Rowing Coastal
Championships are the ultimate
competitive test of endurance and
perseverance. (Teams of) Rowers
compete against each other and the
dynamic conditions of the coast
across a 4-6 km racecourse,
customized according to the natural
local layout and water conditions.

Coastal Championships feature one-person (1x), two-person (2x) and four-person boats with coxswain (4x+) categories.

Multiple race classes include men, women, and mixed gender teams.

A perfect complement to the Beach Sprint Rowing Finals, the Coastal Championships are a grassroots / mass participation event, which sees Rowing clubs and/or National Teams from all over the world competing for glory and medals. The races can be held either the weekend before or following the Beach Sprint Rowing Finals.

Customized Race Courses

Coastal Rowing race courses vary based on local coast line and water conditions.
They are usually designed by World Rowing in collaboration with Organizing Committees to allow for safe & competitive racing and for best possible broadcast coverage.



Beach Sprint Rowing

Simple. Head-to-head. Thrilling.

Beach Sprint Rowing is a vibrant head-to-head elimination format of Rowing, hosted on sandy beaches worldwide. The athletes sprint along the beach to their boats, and row through the crashing shore waves in a dynamic test of power, skill, navigation, and adaptability.


Over an exhilarating three-day weekend, the World Rowing and the European Rowing Beach Sprint Finals feature one-person (1x), two-person (2x) and four-person with coxswain boats (4x+) races.

Multiple competitive classes include men, women, and mixed gender categories.

- 1. Sprint to your boat
- 2. Jump in & start rowing
- 3. 250m slalom to the 3rd buoy
- 4. 180° spin around 3rd buoy
- 5. 250m straight back towards
- 6. Jump out & sprint to the finish-line buzzer
- 7. Buzz first to win the race



In October 2023,

the International Olympic Committee announced at its 141st IOC Session in Mumbai, India, that Beach **Sprint Rowing will make** its full Olympic debut at the LA28 Summer Olympic Games.



Olympic inclusion is a valuable testament to the impressive and organic growth of Beach Sprint Rowing, fueled by its accessibility and modern values.

Launched in 2011, Beach Sprint Rowing has very quickly and significantly grown its global participant and fan base in over 100 countries, signifying the future of global urban youth sport, and will also feature at the Dakar 2026 Youth Olympic Games.

BEACH SPRINT ROWING FIELD OF PLAY

Approx. 80m x 70m of gentle sloping sandy beach with access to gentle waves and 250m x 25m open water



COASTAL ROWING FIELD OF PLAY

Approx. 4 - 6 km of open water with coastline backdrop and gentle waves

EQUIPMENT

Boats + Oars + Timing, Data & Results Services + Entry & Competition Management Services

The equipment listed above may be procured and/or rented (as applicable) from World Rowing's supplier pool for delivery to the competition venue, reducing complexity for the local organizing committee and establishing the foundation for fair competition.




Sample Budget & Fees

Rowing Coastal & Beach Sprint
Championships is **CHF 1'000'000**.

The Event Budget will vary according to local conditions and costs.
European Rowing events may require a slightly lower investment.

The empowerment of its 159 National Member Federations makes it the only the global authority of the sport. As the oldest international federation, World Rowing has been the first one to join the Olympic Movement. It embodies unique Olympic Heritage with Rowing having been Olympic since the first modern Olympic Games in 1896, part of the inaugural Olympic Virtual Series in 2021 and present at the first edition of Olympic Esports Week in 2023.

The organisation promotes Rowing in all its forms throughout the world. It encourages its development and strengthens the bonds that unite all who enjoy the sport, ensuring the integrity of competitions, the protection of participants and of the environment are at the heart of all its activities.

World Rowing establishes the rules and regulations for Classic/Elite-, Coastal-, Para- and Indoor Rowing and approves the Rowing programmes for international Series, Championships, Continental-, Regional- and Multisport Games, including the Olympic and Paralympic Games.
