## 2024 Report

The objective of the European Rowing Umpiring Commission is to standardize and promote umpiring and to continuously improve the quality of umpiring in general and in particular at all European Rowing Championships and international events in Europe (regattas, beach sprints, para-rowing, indoor, coastal, etc.).

We use a number of tools to achieve this, including providing a consistent core of umpire jury members at European Rowing Championships, offering and providing advice and support to European Rowing on rules and umpire matters, coordinating and developing umpire education programs in the European regions in conjunction with the WRUC, and providing a formal and informal mentoring pathway for National Federation candidates wishing to become WR umpires. As the Commission consists of three WRUC members and two non-WRUC European members, the work involves transferring all experience and knowledge to the new ERUC members and working closely and sharing the workload with the WRUC.

As the ERUC started its work at the beginning of 2024, the activities included the selection of the 2024 and 2025 ER Championships Juries, the training and education of the WR umpires and the participation in all 2024 ER regattas as Jury President or as an ERUC member supporting the selected Jury.
