Event Sustainability Report Brazilian National Beach Sprint Championship Vitória, Espírito Santo | November 27–30 2025

1. Introduction

From November 27 to 30 2025, the city of Vitória, Espírito Santo, hosted the *Brazilian National Beach Sprint Championship*. Throughout the event, we implemented a series of sustainability-focused initiatives aimed at educating participants and reducing environmental impact. This report summarises the main actions undertaken and the outcomes achieved.

2. Environmental Education and Awareness

During the championship, several activities were organised to engage athletes, coaches, and staff in our sustainability mission. Informational sessions and on-site interactions helped raise awareness about the importance of environmental protection and responsible practices in sports events.

3. Partnership with Projeto TAMAR

A notable highlight of the event was the partnership established with <u>Projeto TAMAR</u>, a nationally recognised programme dedicated to protecting sea turtles along the Brazilian coastline. This collaboration strengthened our environmental message and provided participants with valuable insights into marine conservation.









4. Waste Reduction Measures

To combat plastic waste:

- Single-use plastic bottles were **eliminated** from the event.
- Two large **water refill stations** were installed approximately 50 meters from the competition area, ensuring easy access to potable water while reducing reliance on disposable plastics.

These measures significantly reduced the volume of plastic used and encouraged the adoption of sustainable hydration habits among participants.



5. Daily Beach Clean-Up Activities

At the end of each competition day, athletes and teams joined together in **coordinated beach clean-up efforts**. This collective activity not only improved the local environment but also reinforced the shared responsibility of maintaining clean and healthy coastal ecosystems.



6. Event Outcomes and Conclusions

The Brazilian National Beach Sprint Championship was a remarkable success, demonstrating that high-level sporting events can be aligned with responsible environmental practices. The level of engagement and cooperation from all participants indicates that we are moving in the right direction toward a more sustainable future.
