



World Rowing Member Federation Accreditation Policy for

World Rowing Beach Sprint Finals

Version: January 2026

World Rowing's policy is to allow accreditations proportional to the size of the participating teams. The following maximum numbers of accreditations for teams will be issued.

Category	Allowed numbers	Access
Athletes	Officially entered for racing + a Maximum of 3 spare rowers (Seniors) + maximum of 3 spare rowers (Under 19) for a full team	AF
Boat Handler*	Max 3 per crew (if 2 or more boat handlers are participating, both genders must be represented). Teams are encouraged to use same boat handlers for different crews of the Member federation.	AF
Coach	1 coach per Crew, 1 Head coach for Men, 1 Head coach for Women, 1 Head Coach for Para.	A
Team Manager	1 (Senior teams), 1 (Under 19 teams)	A
Team Doctors	1 Max per Team	AF
Team Support	Max 4 Team support. Team support shall include: physios, equipment staff, trailer drivers, nutrition experts etc	A
MF Delegates	2 Max per MF.	A
MF Guest	No MF Guest accreditations would be issued. It is expected that MF Guests buy tickets for the grandstands to observe the event.	Not Applicable

Please note: Coaches, Team managers and Team Support that will act as Boat Handlers, must chose Boat Handler as the accreditation category.
